5. Please keep digital manipulation to a minimum; your photograph should faithfully represent the scene as you saw it.
6. Submitted images should be at a minimum of A5 size.
7. Images must not include a watermark or border.
8. You will retain copyright of your entries at all times and will always be credited alongside your picture.
9. By entering this competition, you grant us a non-exclusive licence to display your photograph in connection with this contest. This may include syndication of the winning photographs by the media (but only in connection with this contest). Winners will always be informed if their photographs are syndicated and will always be credited next to their image.
10. Under no-circumstance will we use submitted images for commercial gain unless it has been agreed on a case by case basis with the photographer.
11. The deadline for entry is 15th March 2010.
12. *People's Choice* prize voting will be run on 20th March 2010 at the Whitchurch Green Fair.
13. All winners will be announced on 27th March 2010 at the Earth Hour event in the Gill Nethercott Centre.
14. Prize values may depend on number of entrants.
